

**3.0****Andy's Photoshop Tip #10 - How to change the color of an existing image****1**

If you have an image, but would like to change the color so that it goes better with your homepage, just do one of the following steps. We used this example green background for the examples.

**2**

If you would like to change the color of an image click on **IMAGE/ADJUST/HUE-SATURATION**. To make this image purple, I entered +100 in the HUE and clicked Ok.

**3**

To change the green image to red, select **IMAGE/ADJUST/HUE-SATURATION** and click on the **COLORIZE** checkbox. Adjust the HUE to change the image color.

**4**

If you would like to make an image lighter so that you can see darker text on it, select **IMAGE/ADJUST/HUE-SATURATION** and move the Lightness to +50.

**5**

If you would like an image darker so that you can see light text on it, select **IMAGE/ADJUST/HUE-SATURATION** and move the Lightness to -50.
