



Andy's Photoshop #29 - Feathered Edges

This tip explains how you can feather a soft edge around a photograph.



1 Open up your image.



2 Draw a selection with the marquee tool or with the lasso tool.



3 Feather your selection (SHIFT+CTRL+D). I used a setting of 5 here. Now invert your selection (CTRL+SHIFT+I). Now fill the selection (EDIT...FILL) with the color you want it to blend into (white in this case).



4 To make a larger blend, increase the feather pixel amount (I used 10 in this example).

Although I used an odd shape for the selection area, it could have also been a box or a circle.
